1. Policy Statement

Cathodic Protection Co Ltd (CPCL) strives to ensure the aspects of our business will incorporate the principles of sustainability. We will strive to integrate sustainability into the business values as an employer, manufacturer, and purchaser on a global scale.

Our business faces some real challenges, but there are also opportunities. We seek to reduce our Carbon Footprint by reducing waste, by investing in infrastructure to reduce our reliance on typical energy sources, and by reducing our carbon footprint with the overhaul of our company car, fleet policies with a target to go carbon neutral by 2030.

2. Our focus:

6. To ensure that all staff are aware of our environmental standards and shared responsibilities by challenging improvement in our supply chains and partnership networks
7. Through wider policies to ensure high quality of new development through good product design.
